Entry Deadlines will be STRICTLY ENFORCED!

All animals must have current Rabies Vaccination, current Health Certificate and Negative B.V.D. Testing Certificate. These papers MUST be checked prior to unloading. NO EXCEPTIONS!

- The Entry form is required to be postmarked by July 1, 2017 and will be accepted on a first come-first serve basis until the capacity of the cattle area is obtained. (See Rules & Regulations)
- A \$10.00 late entry fee will be assessed to any entry form postmarked July 2, 2017 through July 8, 2017.
- **Payment and a copy of Registration Papers** (if applies) must accompany **entry form** to be accepted. Lack of forms or payment will delay registration.
- **NO entry form will be accepted postmarked later than July 8th.**
- **EACH Exhibitor MUST purchase a \$5.00 Exhibitor ticket.** Helper(s) ticket(s) will be available. (See Rules and Regulations)
- **Entrance Fee:** 10% of 1st Premium for **each class.** **Animals cannot be entered in BOTH Breed and Market classes with exception of a calf from cow/calf pair.** EXCLUDES classes for Grand & Reserve Champion, Showmanship, and Special Awards.
- Multiple entries accepted. **NO exhibitor shall be allowed to receive more than one premium for any class without competition. NO exhibitor shall be allowed to receive more than two premiums for any class where only one farm or family's animals are exhibited.**
- In cow and calf class, both animals have to be owned by the same exhibitor. Calf must be over 30days old and may be shown in individual class.
- Registration certificates must be available for inspection and must show ownership 60 days prior to opening day of fair.
- Group class of (3) animals must be owned by the same exhibitor and each exhibitor shall be limited to one entry per breed.
- Animal arrival times:
 1. Monday, July 17th, 2pm – 8 pm
 2. Tuesday, July 18th, 8:30 am – Noon
 3. Wednesday, July 19th, 3pm – 8 pm
 4. ANIMALS are expected to stay through 8 pm Saturday, July 22nd.
 5. NO animal is to be unloaded without veterinary inspection.
 6. All stalls MUST be cleaned prior to leaving or you will forfeit your premiums
