- Entrance Fee: 10% of 1st Premium.
- Each exhibitor MUST purchase an Exhibitor Ticket, \$5.00.
- **Entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis until the capacity of the cattle area is obtained.** (See Section 5 of Rules & Regulations)
- Entries must be received by the Dairy Superintendent by Monday, July 12th.
- **ALL CATTLE MUST BE TEST NEGATIVE FOR BOVINE VIRAL DIARRHEA. NO TEST, NO ENTRY**

All animals must have current Rabies Vaccination.

- Each entry also MUST have current Health Certificate **WITH PROPER IDENTIFICATION.**
- All cattle MUST be registered and registration papers must be presented upon request.
- All exhibits MUST be on grounds by 12 noon, July 20th unless otherwise provided for, and are to remain on the grounds until 8:00pm Saturday.
- All bulls MUST be led on the grounds with staff and ring.
- NO cattle will be allowed on the grounds that are not entered for premiums.
- Judging will take place Thursday at 10:00am. (See number 17 under Rules & Regulations)
- Entries are open to all cattle in New York State.
- Only one premium will be awarded to an exhibitor in a single class unless there is a competition between exhibitors.

All animals must have current Rabies Vaccination, current Health Certificate and Negative B.V.D. Testing Certificate. These papers MUST be checked prior to unloading. NO EXCEPTIONS.

- Competition is open to all. Multiple entries accepted.
- No exhibitors shall be allowed to receive more than two premiums for any one class where only one animal is called for.
- Entries must be received by the Beef Superintendent by Monday, July 12th
- Animals will be judged FRIDAY, July 23, 2010 at 3:00 pm.
- The entry fee will be 10% of first place premium. Each exhibitor MUST purchase an exhibitor ticket which is \$5.00. Helper tickets will be available. (See Rules and Regulations)
- Exhibitors, when entering, please state on entry blank the number of stalls desired.
- Exhibitors can bring animals to the fair starting Tuesday, July 20th after 2:00pm & must be in by Thursday, July 22nd at 10:00am and stay through Saturday, July 24th, 8:00pm. Please contact superintendent with your estimated time of arrival.
- **Entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis until the capacity of the cattle area is obtained.**
- In cow and calf class, both animals have to be owned by the same exhibitor. Calf must be over 30 days old and may be shown in individual class.
- Registration certificates should be available for inspection and must show ownership 60 days prior to opening day of the fair.
- Group class of (3) animals must be owned by the same exhibitor and each exhibitor shall be limited to one entry per breed.
