Exhibitor's Ticket \$5.00 (one per farm, all farm entries must be made at one time)

1. All youth showing must be 18 years of age or younger as of January 1st. All youth showing are required to wear an approved safety helmet while riding on show grounds. All over fences – all riders must have helmet.
2. Negative coggins and rabies certificates needed to show. Please drop off copy at show office when you arrive. According to state law, rabies shot must be given at least 14 days before show.
3. Once division has started, classes may be scratched, but **NO refunds** given.
4. Adding classes must be done 2 classes prior to start.
5. Judges decision is final.
6. The Hemlock Fair Association, show management and show staff assume no responsibility in case of loss or damage to horses, exhibitors or equipment from cause, and upon this condition only, will entries be accepted. Fall of horse or rider will constitute medical sign off before continued showing.
7. All classes have paybacks. Paybacks must have 6 entries. Paybacks are as follows: \$10, \$7, \$5 and \$3, with 6 ribbons.
8. **FEES** All classes \$5.00 Stalls \$10.00 per day.

Open to all horses and ponies. Class to be judged on horses' performance. Fences not to exceed 2'6.
