**All riders 18 years of age and under must wear helmets when mounted, no exceptions.**

1. Negative coggins and rabies certificates needed to show. Please present copies at show office when you arrive. According to state law, rabies vaccine must be given at least 14 days before show.
2. FEES: All classes \$5.00. Stalls \$15.00 per day (upon availability).
3. Non-showing horses will be charged a \$20 non-showing fee.
4. Each horse/rider combination must have own number to show.
5. Proper attire and hat/helmet required.
6. All classes with 6 or more entries offer paybacks. Paybacks are as follows: \$10, \$7, \$5, and \$3 with 6 ribbons awarded in each class.
7. Fall of horse or rider will constitute medical sign off before rider can continue showing.
8. Judges decision is final.
9. Failure to comply with rules will result in forfeit of premiums earned.
10. An open check or full payment must be in office before numbers are issued.
11. Classes will be run in order by class number.
12. Classes with 3 or less entries may be combined.
13. Champion and Reserve ribbons will be awarded for each division.
14. The Hemlock Fair Association, show management and show staff assume no responsibility in case of loss or damage to horses, exhibitors or equipment from cause, and upon this condition only, will entries be accepted.
15. All stalls used must be cleaned before you leave the fairgrounds.

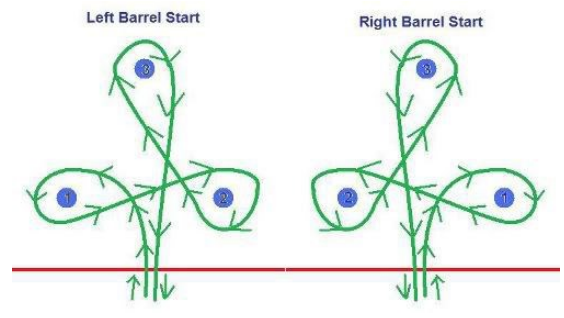
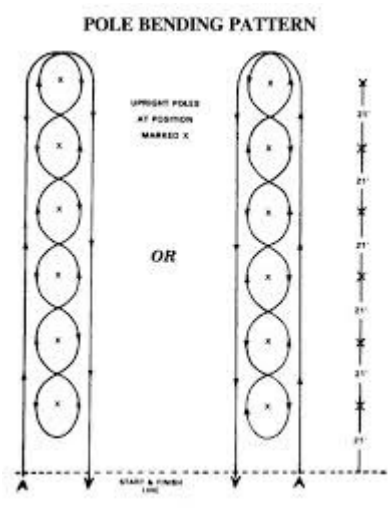
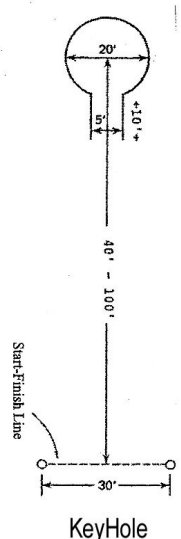
**Divisions**

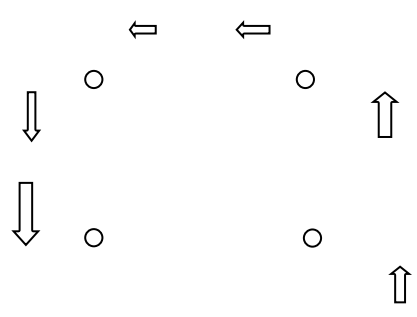
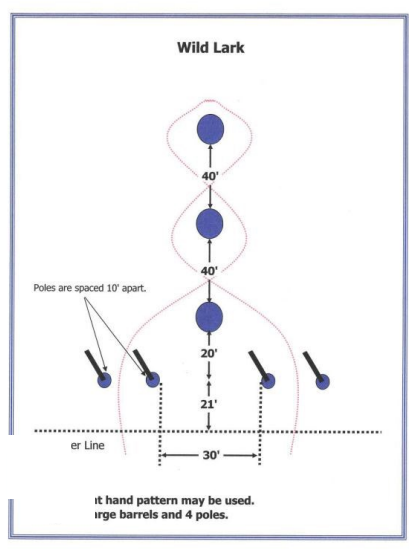

**CHUG RACE:**

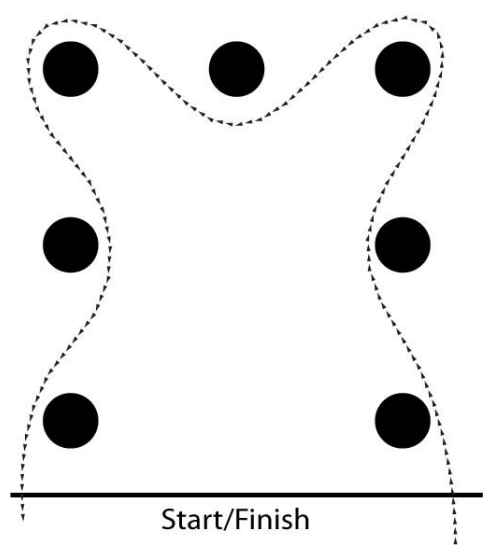
Riders ride to far end of arena where a barrel holds a cup of water. Rider may stay mounted or dismount, pick up cup, chug full cup of water, turn cup over, drop on barrel and race back to finish line. Fastest time wins. 5 second penalty for not drinking all of the water.



**CAN RACE:**

A can is placed on top of each barrel. Rider is given a stick and may ride either direction. Staying on the outside of the barrels rider must knock the can over as they pass by the barrel. Fastest time wins. Disqualified for not hitting can.

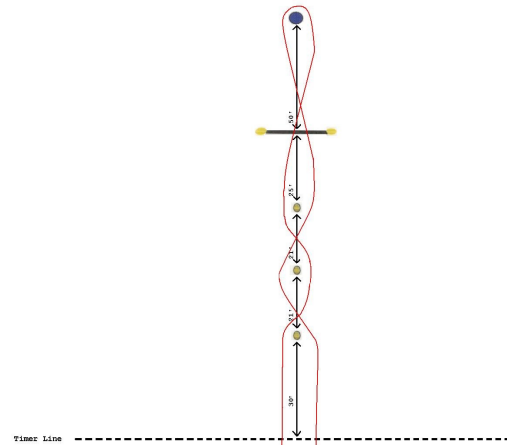


## RIBBON RACE

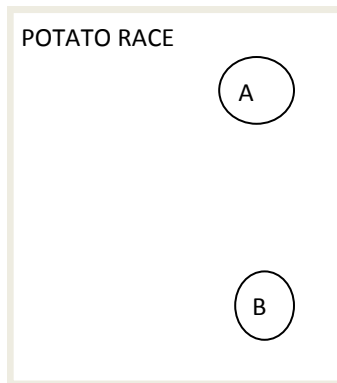
**COURSE:** Riding in pairs, riders will each hold the end of a ribbon. They may ride left or right, but must ride around the outside of all the barrels and back through the finish line without dropping the ribbon. Fastest time wins.

Disqualification for dropping ribbon.

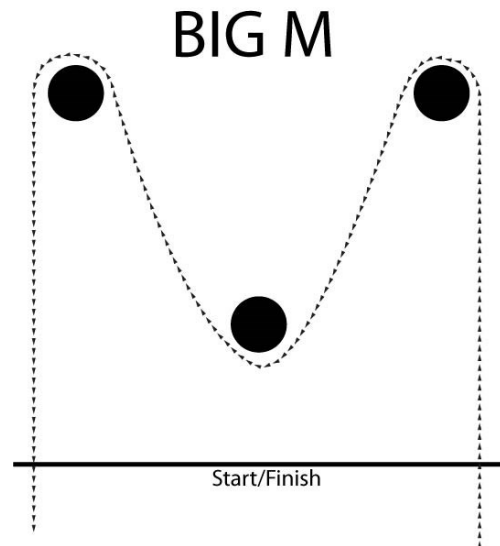
## BEND & JUMP Scramble



Left or right hand pattern may be used.  
Equipment: 3 Poles, 1 Large Barrel, 1 Jump



The rider goes to the far end of arena where a potato is on barrel A. Rider will pick up potato ride to barrel B, drop potato into barrel and race back through finish line. Rider disqualified if they fail to put potato into barrel B. 5 second penalty for knocking over a barrel or using hand, arm or leg to steady barrel.
